



The Story of Santes Dwynwen

Did you know that Wales has its very own patron Saint of Love which we celebrate on January 25th? Our Welsh saint of love is **Santes Dwynwen** and there is a poignant story to tell.

Dwynwen was said to be the prettiest of the 24 daughters of **Brychan Brycheiniog**, the king of Brecon (South Wales). She fell passionately in love with **Maelon** Dafodrill who was denied her hand in marriage by her father as a more suitable match had already been arranged. Maelon took his anger out on Dwynwen and left her in a fit of rage.

She ran away to the ancient woodlands, fell to the ground and cried herself to sleep asking God to free her from her heartache. While sleeping she dreamt an angel came and told her Maelon would no longer trouble her as he had been turned into a block of ice.

The angel then granted her **three wishes**.

Her first wish was for Maelon to be thawed.

The second was for true love to be protected in her name for all the lovers of Wales.

Her third wish was that she would never again fall in love, nor marry.

All three of her wishes came true.

Dwynwen left home to prevent her father from making her marry for power or greed. She then became a nun and travelled Wales, setting up churches and praying for those troubled in love.

So much can be derived from this story. One is that even though her heart was broken, she still believed in the power of love, and another is that you can live your life in love even if you are standing alone. The common ground is the belief that love is a feeling, an emotion and an act that needs protecting and celebrating in any way we can. ❤️
