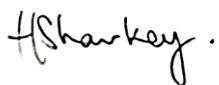
Cyd-destun y tymor: Cynefin

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Croeso nôl – Welcome back

Annwyl deuluoedd / Dear families,

It is lovely to be able to welcome our pupils back to school today for the new academic year. The children are full of their summer tales and it is clear that there has been much enjoyment and relaxation. I hope you have also had a good summer break. We are pleased to see our children settling into their new classes and into the new year with new energy, enthusiasm and ambition.

On behalf of the whole school community, I extend a very warm welcome to children and families who are joining us for the first time; we hope that you will settle well in our wonderful community. There are a few new faces on the school staff this year. A warm welcome to **Miss Taylor** in the office, **Mrs Hollingsworth** in the Nursery, **Miss Evans** in 2C and **Miss Moreno** who is working in many places across the school. We are also pleased to be able to welcome **Miss Lisa Jones** to us as a teacher in 4C until Christmas. As you are aware, **Mrs Wendy Owen** will be Acting Deputy Headteacher for the Autumn term.

I would like to take the opportunity at the start of a term like this to send a reminder of key messages that support the wellbeing and progress of each of our pupils and wider community.

Absence and Attendance

Good attendance is key to every child's growth. Every day at school counts. We have high expectations of attendance and punctuality for all children and most of our children maintain very high standards. We ask that you ensure that your child is present at school at all times. Should your child need to stay home due to illness, you are required to leave a message with the school office stating a specific reason for the absence, including specific details about the illness.

The first few minutes of the morning are an important time for pupils when arriving at school to settle into class. This is also a time where staff work with children to support their wellbeing. We ask that you ensure that your children arrive at school promptly and before the gates close at 9am.

Park and travel to school

We encourage all families to travel sustainably by walking or cycling to school wherever possible. Parking near the school continues to be a challenge for the school families and the village community. Maintaining a close relationship with our neighbours is very important to us and we therefore ask that you avoid having to park near the school if possible, parking at the bottom of the village and walking the short distance to the school. The school's Walking Bus leaves Heol Berry every day at 8.50, under the care of staff, and is a safe and secure way to get to school. We ask everyone to park considerately and to show respect and courtesy to everyone at all times.

The school Bike Bus will resume soon and we will be sharing bus dates shortly.

School Lunches

To ease arrangements and to ensure that pupils receive the lunch of their choice, we ask that you ensure that your children's dinners are ordered in advance.

Healthy Eating

Children who eat healthy learn better, feel better and grow stronger. For children who bring a lunch box to school, we ask that you ensure that the contents of the food box are healthy. We also ask that every snack is healthy. We expect all children to bring a bottle of water to school every day that contains only water.

School Essentials Grant

For families on lower incomes, the School Essentials Grant is available to help with the costs of the school day, including school uniform. We encourage you to apply for this if you are eligible. This also leads to additional funding for the school.
